Objective: Evaluating the potential for the development of Nacala Corridor, the survey prepared a medium and long-term development plan of Nacala Port up to 2020 and after as the gateway of the corridor. Within the frame work of the medium and long- term plan, a short-term plan and an urgent plan to be completed by 2015 were elaborated.
