Client: Japan International Cooperation Agency, Government of Cambodia

Period: January 2006 - March 2008

Objective: Improving security facilities and equipment in surveillance of persons and cargoes in the port area and assist to establish a firm security structure to meet the mandatory ISPS Codes. And by introduction of port security systems applying ISPS Codes, Cambodian exports will be accepted by the security strict countries including USA. This effect will contribute to export promotion, continuing industrial development and employment opportunity.

Main Activities
