
Objective: This Study was carried out as SAPROF (Special Assistance for Project Formulation). The study is to develop oil supply base for the exploitation of oil and Natural gas in the Gulf of Thailand and a deep draft multi-purpose terminal. A development project up to 2020 was formulated and the feasibility of the project was evaluated. In the course of the project formulation, efficient and smooth operation of the whole port and the impact on the natural and social environment were duly taken into consideration.

Main Activities

Assigned fields: Sub-leader/ Port engineering specialist

Summary of activities:

- Zoning of the port back-up area
- > Streamlining of cargo movement by rationalization of port road system
- Preparation of layout plans of terminal facilities for the oil supply base and 50,000 DWT dry bulk carriers.
- Examination of the capacities of tug boats for safe maneuvering of large ships.
